AIR RAID SHELTERS

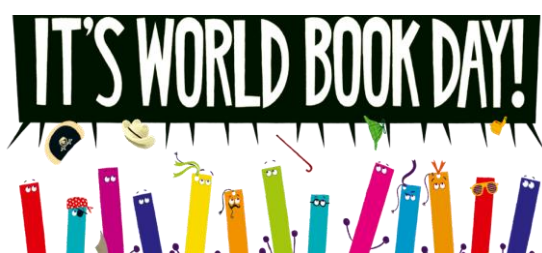
