# **NATURE NINJAS**

The Nature Ninjas have been incredibly busy today preparing the school grounds for the spring by planting approximately 200 daffodil and tulip bulbs across various spots around the school. When these bulbs bloom in spring, the flowers will provide an essential early food source (nectar and pollen) for pollinating insects like bees and butterflies waking up from their winter rest. Mike from Collins Landscapes spoke to them about how to plant bulbs properly so they grow well. He went over all of the changes we have already made in school to attract more wildlife like the pond and the planters at the entrance.
