FIRST AID

This week, Years 5 and 6 have had a session of first aid training with Chris from Millie's Trust. The children learnt about what to do in an emergency situation, including how to call for help, what information to provide, and what steps they should take to help someone. All the children got chance to practise putting someone into the recovery position and used dummies to learn how to administer CPR. They also learnt about choking and how to use a defibrillator.

We hope that these essential skills will stay with the children - they could help to save a life one day.
