

# STOCKPORT RESIDENT ADVICE AND SUPPORT TEAM

You may have noticed a small area of our playground cordoned off (just by the corner of the building). We currently have bees in that area.

Pest control have been to site and have informed us there is nothing they can do to remove them and they could be with us for a month or so. They have assured us the bees are safe and will not sting unless antagonised.



The newly formed RAS team are there to help residents with the current cost-of-living crisis.

Bringing together the debt advice team, welfare rights and support funds, as well as brand new cost-of-living navigators, the RAS team is the first port of call for residents seeking support.

- Checks on benefit and pension credit entitlement
- Financial support for rent and other essential items
- Help finding the right community support
- Helping with debt and paying council bills
- Help being more digital-getting online and staying safe online
- Help with accessing national cost of living support
